Thomas Kwasi Tiekú is an Associate Professor of Political Science and Coordinator of the Social Justice and Peace Studies Program in King's University College at Western University in Ontario, Canada. A former director of African Studies and an award winning professor at the University of Toronto, Professor Tiekú's current research focuses on conflict mediation and negotiation, peacebuilding, regional governance innovations, international organizations, defence and security policies, as well as the West and Africa relations. He has published three (3) monographs and over twenty-two (22) refereed journal articles and book chapters. His latest book (2016) is *Governing Africa: 3D Analysis of the Performance of African Union*. Professor Tiekú serves on a number of editorial and advisory boards, including Cornell University's African Development Monograph Series and American Social Science Research Council's African Peacebuilding Network. He has also served as a consultant to a number of organizations and governments, including the World Bank Group, Centre for International Governance Innovations, and Department of National Defence, and Global Affairs Canada.
