

Introduction of meat products

As long as they are free of pests and come in quantities fit for personal use and consumption.

General considerations:

Their packaging must be intact, with labels in Spanish, English or any other intelligible language (Italian, Portuguese, French, etc.), and the seal of the health authority.

They must originate from countries that meet a combination of requirements from the [Zoosanitary Requirements Query Unit for imports](#).

Pursuant to the Zoosanitary Requirements Sheet, only the goods sourced from authorized plants registered at the [Information System for Authorized Plants](#) (SICPA) will be allowed.

Any presentation as long as the total does not exceed the allowed quantity.

The introduction of the following is prohibited:

Artisanal products

Food preparations containing beef or similar meats, such as meatballs, lasagna, ravioli, etc.
