## Immigration and Visas

- **Countries that do not require a visa:**

<b>Argentina</b>	<b>United States</b>
<b>Bahamas</b>	<b>Jamaica</b>
<b>Barbados</b>	<b>Panama</b>

Citizens from those countries must show the following documents at Immigration in Mexico:

- a) Passport or travel document valid under international law.
- b) Mexican Immigration Form duly filled out. This form will be distributed in the airplane or at Immigration.
- c) Immigration authorities could also request travelers to demonstrate the objective of their trip, by showing for instance their invitation letter, hotel reservation and/or return flight ticket to their country of origin.

- **Countries that require a visa:**

Citizens of those countries who submit any of the following documents will NOT require to apply for a Mexican visa:

- a) Document that shows permanent residence in Canada, United States, Japan, United Kingdom, or any country of the Schengen Area (European Union + Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland).
- b) United States valid visa.
- c) Business Traveler Card (ABTC) approved by Mexico.
- d) Certificate accrediting you as a member of the crew of the aircraft in which you traveled

Those who are unable to provide the aforementioned documents can apply for a Mexican visa at any of the Mexican embassies or consulate, where you must show:

- a) Letter requesting the visa
- b) Passport valid for at least 6 additional months after the end date of your trip.
- c) Visa request form duly completed and signed. This form can be obtained at your embassy or consulate.
- d) A passport photo, size: 45 x 35mm, in color, facing forward
