AUTHORIZED VEGETABLE PRODUCTS AND BYPRODUCTS FOR TOURIST IMPORT

All products listed in item FOURTH of the AGREEMENT that establishes the classification and coding of imported goods subject to regulation by the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, Rural Development, Fishing, and Food, through the National Service of Food Safety and Agriculture Quality, are authorized for entry subject only to a visual inspection, provided that they are free from pests and in amounts for personal use and consumption, such as:
