




Unitization Guidelines

Establish the procedure for the Unitization of National Shared Reservoirs, through the following activities:

- Approve the Pre-Unitization Agreement;
- II. Instruct the Unitization of National Shared Reservoirs;
- III. Approve the terms and conditions of the Unitization Agreement, and
- IV. Determine the terms and conditions of the Unitization Agreement when the parties do not reach an agreement.









Shared fields and reservoirs


What is a shared field/reservoir?

Those fields/reservoirs that extends beyond contract or assignment areas.



Contractual areas designed to minimize shared reservoirs

Blocks that fully covers exploration opportunities

Key concepts on Unitization Guidelines

Pre-Unitization Agreement

- Describes the coordinated activities that will be carried out in a "Possible Shared Reservoir"
- Not yet determined if there is or not hydraulic connection
- For projects in exploration and evaluation periods
- Each operator must comply its own Minimum Work Commitments

Main purpose:

Share information and carry out coordinated activities to determine if the reservoir is shared or not

Unitization Agreement

- Establish terms and conditions to develop Unit Operations in the Unit Area
- Shared reservoir confirmed
- Designed operator
- For projects in development period

For the Unitized Area in surface and depth instructed by SENER



Pre-Unitization Agreement, what for?

- Share information;
- II. Coordinate activities to evaluate a possible shared reservoir;
- III. Minimize capital expenditure;
- IV. Save evaluation time/resources;
- V. Up to two (2) years period to carry out coordinated activities (period extension possible);
- VI. The agreement allows activities in both sides of the border to comply contractual obligations;
- VII. Ease controversy resolution





Pre-Unitization Agreement implementation

Notification of a possible shared reservoir

- Either presented jointly or individually by operators
- Content as established in guidelines

Verification of a possible shared reservoir

 SENER verifies information and request the Pre-Unitization Agreement

Presentation of a Pre-Unitization Agreement

- SENER will request parties to present the Pre-Unitization Agreement
- SENER will have a 20 business days period to solve

Pre-Unitization Agreement

- Up to 2 years and extensible
- Information sharing
- Hydraulic connectivity confirmation
- Gather information to notify Shared Reservoir Discovery

Coordinated activities

- Exploration
- Evaluation
- Delimitation
- Characterization




Unitization Agreement

- ✓ SENER will be assisted by CNH;
- ✓ For Unitization Agreement approval:
 - CNH will solve operator designation within 45 business days
 - SENER will solve UA within 40 business days once operator is approved
 - SENER may adapt UA within 60 business days once operator is approved






Approaches for Unitization Agreement



If no UA reached, SENER may consult an independent third party. Both operators may jointly propose that expert.





Unitization in E&P Contracts

contiguous ssignee Unitization with Contractor / As

Notification

- Existence of a shared reservoir to SENER & CNH
- Within 60 business days
- Technical support
- G&G Studies
- Work program proposal

Technical opinion

- From CNH to SENER within 45 business days
- Opinion from SHCP required

SENER instructs unitization

- Within 30 business days
- Guidelines applicable to request information
- SENER will determinate terms and conditions if no information is received

contiguous Assignee Unitization without Contractor

Notification

- Existence of a shared reservoir to CNH
- Technical support
- G&G Studies

Continuity of E&P activities


- As approved Plans
- SENER will determinate how to proceed in non contractual/assigned areas







