Basic Principles

In a spirit of international cooperation both institutions propose to draw up a bi-national plan with the purpose of developing an interchange of educational and cultural projects with the , object of offering a series of benefits for the citizens of the United States and Mexico.

Objectives

1. The joint offering of seminars, courses of higher education and specialized technical training with the administration of these programs by personnel of either one or both institutions.
2. Cultural, sport, and social interchanges.
3. Interchange of administrative, teaching, and student personnel in educational programs including those related to self development.
4. Interchange of equipment and educational material.
5. Interchange of fellowships of both institutions.
6. Interchange of the use of physical plant (classrooms, libraries, workshops, equipment and laboratories of both institutions).
7. Interchange of statistical, technical and educational information.
8. Planning research studies on the common problems of both institutions (examples:) socio-economic, ecological, and technical studies, etc.)
9. Development of any pilot programs of an experimental nature in different areas.

With the purpose of initiating and implementing some of these agreements, the following is agreed to:

- A. The formation of a committee composed of three representatives from each institution.
- B. Visits to the physical plants by representatives of both institutions.
- C. The initiation in the month following the signing of this agreement of interchange programs among the different administrative and academic department heads.
