Actions to protect the livestock production of the country

In our country, the zoosanitary activity is focused in the application of strategies that allow the control and/or eradication of pests and diseases that affect our livestock production.

Jointly with subsidiary bodies, the state delegations of the Secretariat of Agriculture and Rural Development (SADER) and the state governments, the National Service for Agro-Alimentary Public Health, Safety and Quality (SENASICA) coordinates the preparation and implementation of strategic plans to combat and control pests and diseases, and achieve the objectives and goals of each campaign.

Strategic plans are centered in the operation of the programs and in the projects associated with each zoosanitary campaign, to guarantee the sanitary progress of zones, regions and states.

It is important to point out that the information generated by the operation of the zoosanitary campaigns in the states is collected, analyzed and disseminated in a timely, homologated and transparent fashion.
