## Activities for a pest and disease free country

The Phytosanitary Epidemiological Surveillance Program is active throughout the country, reaching agricultural, wild, marginalized and urban areas, identified as high-risk for quaternary importance pests to enter, establish and multiply.

Currently, active and passive epidemiological surveillance for pests is in effect in the main production systems in the country with operative actions such as: trapping routes, sentinel plots, surveillance routes, exploration areas, trapping nurseries and sentinel plants.
