The state of Michoacán adds new pest-free zones.



The Secretariat of Agriculture and Rural Development, through the Senasica, applies pest and disease surveillance, control and elimination measures, so the food we eat is healthy and free of shape, smell or flavor defects.

When the producers assist the health authorities and comply with the phytosanitary provisions issued through Mexican Official Standards, harmful insects are exterminated and the Secretariat of Agriculture recognizes pest-free zones that increase their productivity and competitiveness.

Commercially speaking producers are no longer under export and movement restrictions for their products, so they can access better markets and improve their quality of life.

The Áporo, Senguio and Lagunillas municipalities of Michoacán were recognized by the Secretariat of Agriculture as zones free of the avocado seed weevil, small avocado seed weevil and avocado fruit borer. This region joins the 39 municipalities that currently can export the fruit to different destinations worldwide.
