The Plant Health Auxiliary Bodies (OASVs) are organizations of agricultural producers that act as assistants to prevent and fight pests that affect crops, through collaboration with phytosanitary programs, development of strategies, procurement and application of economic resources, intervention in support of farmers to manage credit intended for crop protection and promotion and dissemination of the programs.
