

# **National Station of Plant Epidemiology, Quarantine and Sanitation (ENECuSaV)**

The National Station of Plant Epidemiology, Quarantine and Sanitation (ENECuSaV) was established in 2006 by a collaboration agreement between the National Service for Agro-Alimentary Public Health, Safety and Quality (SENASICA), through its General Head Office of Plant Health and the Plant Health State Committee of Queretaro.

The purpose of the ENECuSaV is to provide a safe reference mechanism for the import to Mexico of citrus varieties (and other fruit trees in the medium term) from anywhere in the world, for research, varietal improvement or for use by national citrus farmers. The mechanism includes the diagnosis of diseases and elimination of pathogens, followed by the distribution of the varieties to the units of the National Program of Certification of Citrus Dissemination Materials.
