We are certain that with you as President of the United States, it will be possible to continue implementing the basic principles of foreign policy set forth in our Constitution, especially those of non-intervention and the self-determination of peoples.

I would also like to express my appreciation for your position of supporting Mexico's and the world's migrants, which will allow us to continue the plan of furthering the development and well-being of the communities in southeastern Mexico and the countries of Central America. I believe that, by taking this approach, no one will be forced to leave their country and they will be able to live, work and be happy with their family, among their own people and with their
