Enjoy a special balloon flight where you will be able to appreciate the city from above, a unique experience in every way. You will witness the splendor of the sunrise in an intimate and romantic atmosphere. Upon landing you will have a toast with sparkling wine, to then go to have breakfast.

Breakfast

Duration: 4 hours.

Temporality: Best time of year for flights: is October to June.

Live nature and adventure in the mountain bike challenge and discover the surroundings of San Miguel de Allende by bicycle. On low, medium and high slopes, take the challenge just tailored to your taste on spectacular trails and roads of the semi desert. A guide specialized in interpreting the natural surrounding and cultural scenarios of this privileged landscape will accompany you. Adventure, nature, and culture for all your senses.



This tour is the perfect option for couples who for some reason do not want or can not do the balloon ride since it goes around the Ignacio Allende dam too.

Also, this tour will be offered in the event that the rain does not allow the flight to take place like a light rain or drizzle that can allow a nice tour of the old paths of San Miguel de Allende to take place.

There are several trails of different duration and difficulty:

Beginners: 20 km trail at Atotonilco.
Duration: 2 to 3 hrs.

Intermediate: 30 km trail rolling from Atotonilco to Cruz del Palmar visiting the 10th Indian Chapels.
Duration: 3 hrs.

Advanced: 70 km or more on trails at Dolores Hidalgo river side.
Duration: 5 hrs leaving from Atotonilco.

It includes: helmets, gloves, bicycles to the size of the clients, hydration, protein bar and transfer to Atotonilco

This place witnessed innumerable historical events, one of the most important was when the priest Don Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla after giving the Cry of Independence on September 15, 1810, took from this chapel the banner of the Virgin of Guadalupe, becoming the first national symbol of independent Mexico.







LOOKING FOR THE MIRACLE



Tour of the handicraft market of San Miguel de Allende, your guests will get a large wooden heart painted by hand, which they will have to fill with small representative images of the couple called "miracles" made of the local material of the destination "the brass sheet ". It will be delivered on your wedding day representing the love between you and the qualities that each one has.

Duration: 3 hours.

Includes: Transportation, 50 cm high by 40 cm wide wooden heart and up to 40 miracles.

Restrictions: Minimum 20 people.

Recommendations: Bring comfortable clothes and shoes, for the handicraft market it is recommended to bring cash in case you feel like buying handicraft.



RIDING NEXT TO YOU UPGRADE 1

The ranch where you will start is located about 30 minutes from the city. After a theoretical introduction on riding, you will begin the 2 and a half hour tour with exclusive access to the main canyon of the region.

In the first part of the excursion, you will climb to the top of the ravine, admiring spectacular views. In the river you will gallop at various points and dismount to enjoy a break and to cool off.

You will go up the canyon and go around its impressive 50-meter cliffs, with the most spectacular sceneries and with the option of rappelling these rocks. At the end, a delicious traditional barbecue will be waiting for you. The menu includes cuts of meat, comal tortillas, fresh rancho cheese and organic beans from the ranch itself, quesadillas, nopales, rice, fresh sauces, guacamole, salad, among other typical dishes.

Duration: 5 hours.

Substitution for only lunch has no additional cost.

Includes: Horseback riding, helmets on request, food and transportation.

Restrictions: Maximum capacity 70 people, the transportation capacities are 3, 7 and 14 people.

CEREMONY OF THE ROSES

The origins of the rose ceremony are enigmatic. In many cultures and times, as Celtic and Medieval weddings, symbolic elements used to be exchanged to represent the couple's dedication and their love for the other. At traditional Hawaiian weddings, it is common for the couple to exchange flower necklaces.

But popular belief assumes that the origin of the rose ceremony dates back to one of the oldest civilizations. Greek culture associated the beauty of roses with the goddesses of love. As a result of this cultural heritage, since ancient times, roses have been the flower of love and passion. That is why they have positioned themselves as the favorite flower to give to a partner on any occasion, have at the ceremony, accompany a memorable proposal, an anniversary celebration or to make any day special. An emotional and very special ceremony.



CEREMONY OF THE ROSES



Its development is in two parts. To mark the center of your celebration you will create a beautiful altar. Among the activities that you will carry out are, the lighting of your union candles, the blessing of the roses, of the honey, you will join your hands, express your vows, exchange the rings. When the moment of the kiss come, the petals will rain over you to announce the consummation of your love.

You will take the roses in your hands. When the officiant indicates it, both will exchange the roses at the same time. At the end, you will gather your roses, holding your hands and place them in a vase on the main table. You can take advantage of this moment to read your wedding vows, you will have a magical ceremony.

A variation of this ritual is that, after the wedding, you bring your roses as an offering to the sanctuary of your faith. It is also a popular custom that roses are given to your mother-in-laws as they represent love for the family and respect for the other's mother.

Another way to celebrate this ceremony is to involve your guests: each one will hold a rose and place it in a vase next to the altar. From this bouquet, you or the officiant will take ones to perform the ritual. At the end of the ceremony, the remaining roses can be presented to the guests.

Each grooms or brides must hold a rose. They can be the same color or different shades or your favorite colors, your partner's favorite color, or in colors that have different meanings.

Preferably, the roses should be buttons, so that they bloom after the ceremony and last longer. In addition, the buttons represent beauty, which will flourish if you take care of your love with dedication and love.

Just as each flower in the natural bouquet symbolizes a different feeling and emotion, roses have a different meaning for each color. White roses signify purity, the pink ones are tenderness, the red ones passion and the yellow or orange ones mean happiness. Fantastic colored artificial roses have even been created to better suit each individual's taste.





PREHISPANIC CEREMONY OF THE 4 WINDS

And the earth is also a legitimate giver of knowledge, because - like all other elements - "it has been here long before the appearance of the human soul, and since it is older, it has a much greater experience than that of man."

Second, there is Water, which has the power to unite, integrate and also dissolve. That teaches fluency and also adaptability, that is, the ability to take any shape. The Water that teaches to be transparent, a symbol of life and creation that cleanses and purifies. Even today, many indigenous ceremonies on our continent begin with a washing ritual.

In third place is Air, which is what expands, diffuses and relates. It is present in the breath of man and animals, that breath by which - many of the traditions of the Earth relates - the Creator breathes life into his creatures. Air is, therefore, an unequivocal sign of the presence of life in man, and when life abandons him, the presence of Air, of breath, is also extinguished. Furthermore, Air is the vehicle of light.

And finally there is Fire, what energizes, transforms and liberates. "The fire that is always associated to the concept of purification, primary energy, life, heat, civilization - in the broadest sense of Higher Knowledge". The Fire that is the Sun itself and that presides from the center many of the ceremonial circles and nocturnal rituals of our people.

The ceremony is carried out in 4 stages flowing through a special sequence that will sustain the energy of the ritual. The fundamental essence is to consolidate your love and honor Mother Earth.

It is one of the most common chosen by nature lovers. It is about making the vows inspired by each of the essential elements. It consists of offering the love of the couple to the wind, water, earth and fire. To do this, a kind of conch shell is usually sounded in all four directions while a special incense is burned.

First of all you have the Earth, which is what gives solidity, what gives stability, hardens and isolates, both in the physical, psychic and also spiritual dimensions. Like the Earth, mothers (human and animal) have the ability to turn their own body into food for their children. On earth lie the bones and flesh of our ancestors, and since we are made of Earth, our ancestors also live in us. "In the patient and fruitful womb of our Mother Earth, the embryos of plants and men hide."

WATER AND SAND CEREMONY

These rituals are symbolic actions, representations of the love and will that binds a couple. It can accompany the civil ceremony or a religious, if the beliefs of the couple are not opposed. The important thing is to do them by giving yourself completely to the moment and its meaning. Each couple has its symbols, its language, its style, for this reason, you may feel identified with some of these rituals and want to include them to personalize your wedding.

This simple and profound ceremony will take place before the divine presence of water, ideal for all couples who are simply seeking a blessing, exchanging their promises of love in a sacred, joyful and meaningful moment in the company of their family and loved ones.


The sand ceremony consists of filling two small containers with sand, the couple will hold them and then empty them into a larger container. This sand, as well as the containers, can be colored, carry pebbles or shells. The sand is the symbol of the union of the lives and times of both. The water ceremony follows the same principle and the container can have, for example, flowers or colored powders. The beauty of both elements is that they cannot be separated: drops of water or grains of sand stay together forever after mixing. There are beautiful texts for both ceremonies and they can also be accompanied by poems or songs.



THE CEREMONY



The dedication and beauty with which the native people have continued the ancient ceremonies practiced by our ancestors, have astonished the world for their genuineness, depth and simplicity.



Every wedding ceremony is beautiful. The ceremony can be held outdoors in a garden or a vineyard, surely your hearts know the answer and it will be unforgettable.

These ceremonies are tailored with infinite possibilities, let us know your wishes and needs to create a customized ceremony, we will gladly attend to your request, until you get a one of a kind experience.

The most important thing to carry out any ancestral, symbolic or religious ceremony, is that the couple has conviction and love in it, to surrender, relax, get excited and enjoy it.

Includes: Selected ceremony, elements to perform the ritual, spiritual guide who celebrates the ritual. This ceremony can be substituted by any symbolic ceremony of your liking.
