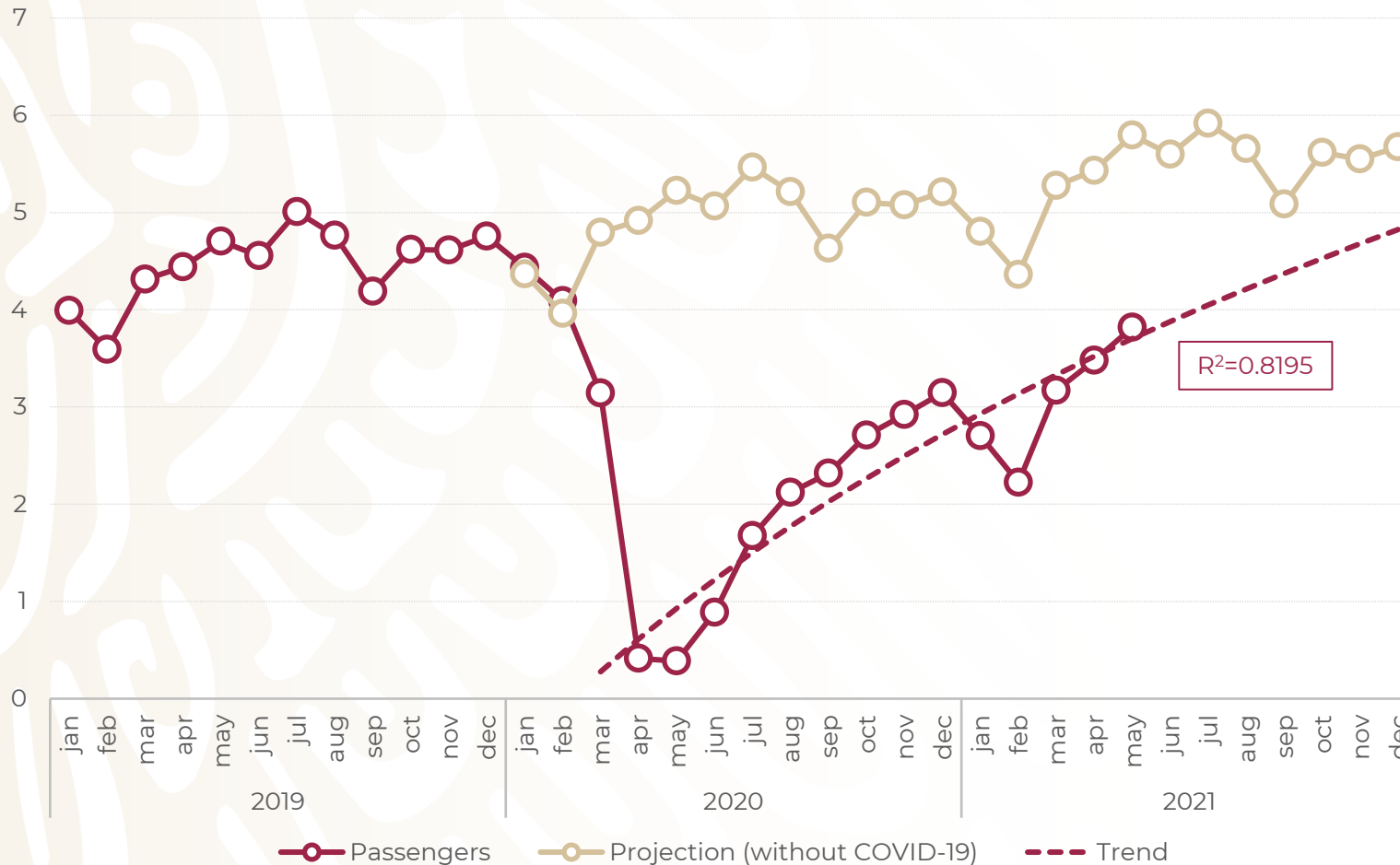

(million passengers)

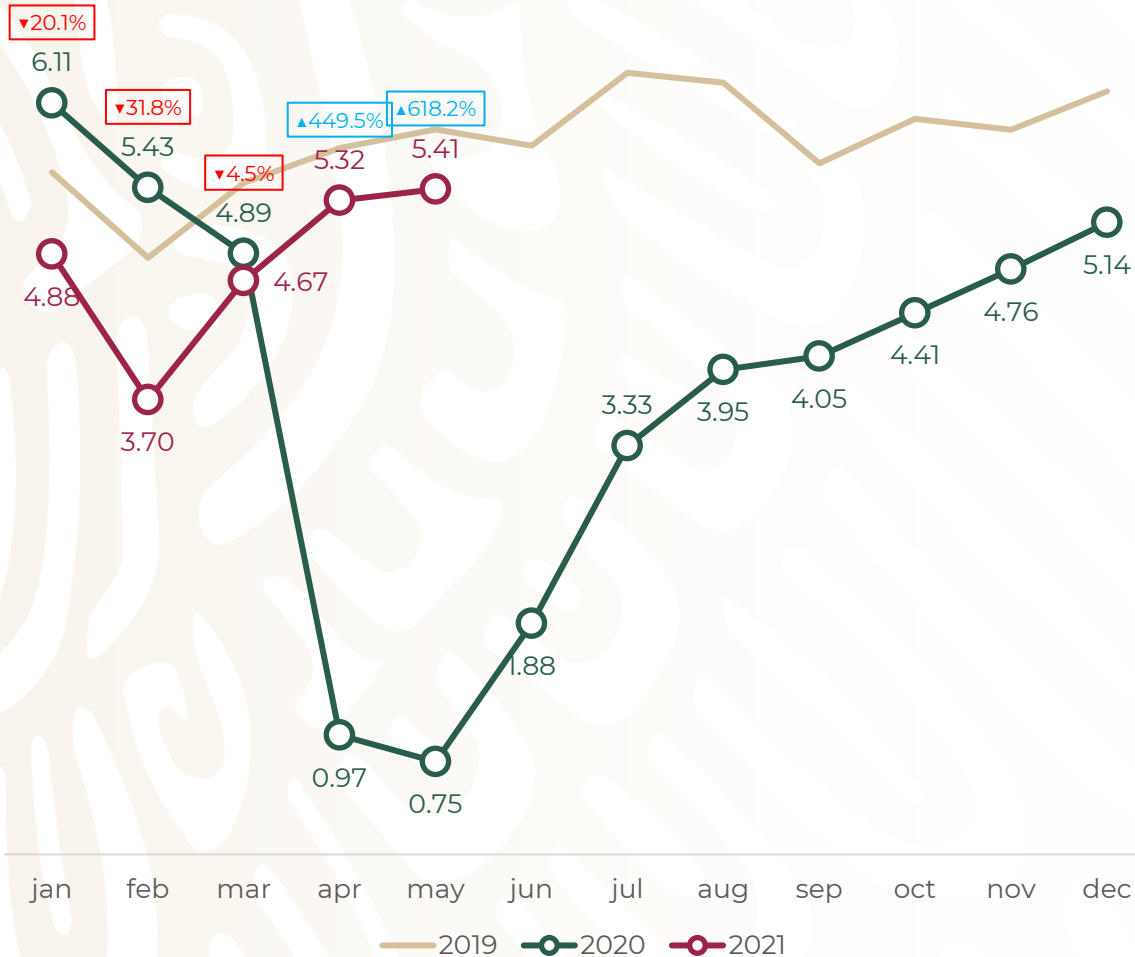


- There were no restrictions on the part of the Mexican authority in air operations.
- Airlines and Airport Groups regulated themselves according to the demand for routes.
- The 9 Mexican passenger airlines did not stop their domestic operations this 2020 (except for one airline, which had no operations in May). Interjet has suspended its operations since December 11, 2020.
- The trend curve indicates a recovery in the domestic passenger market by the first quarter of 2022.

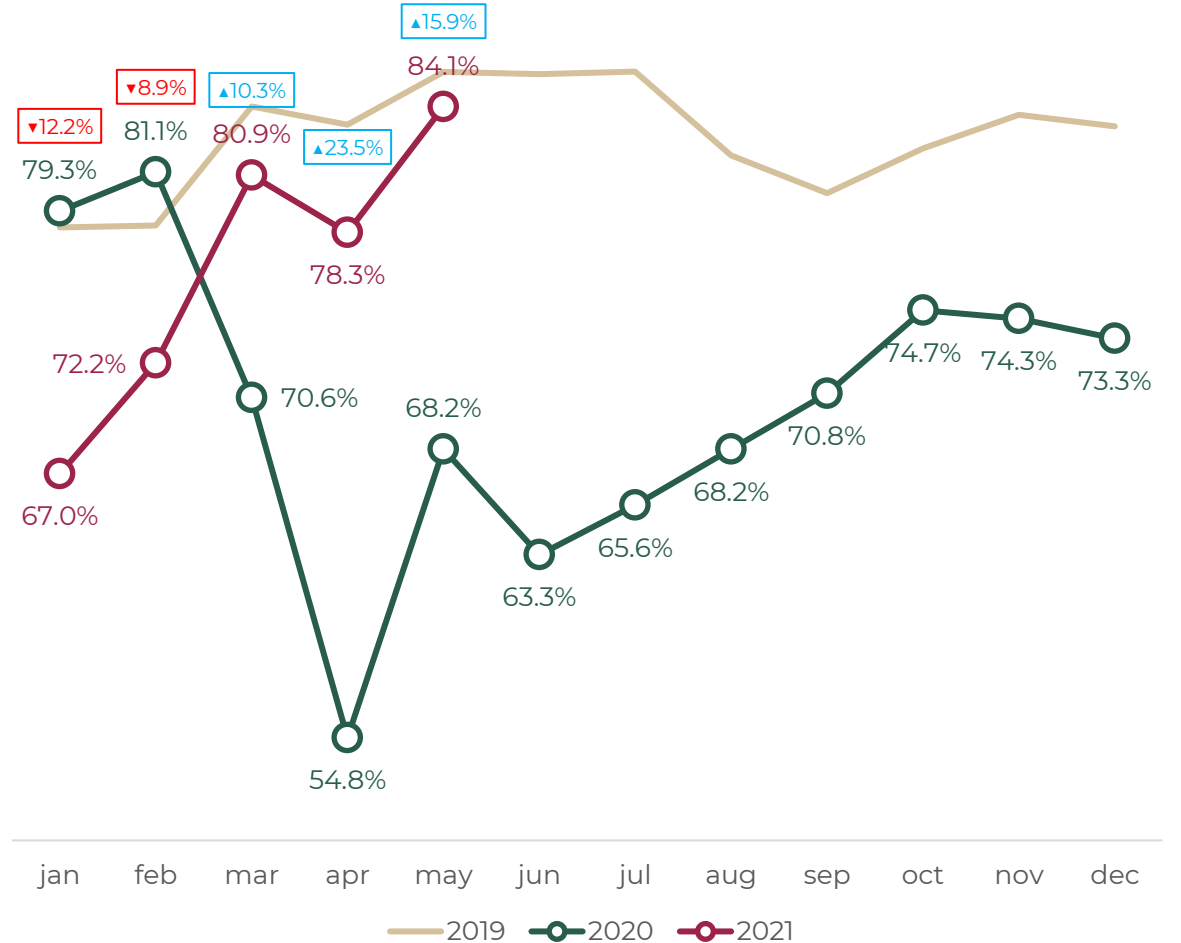

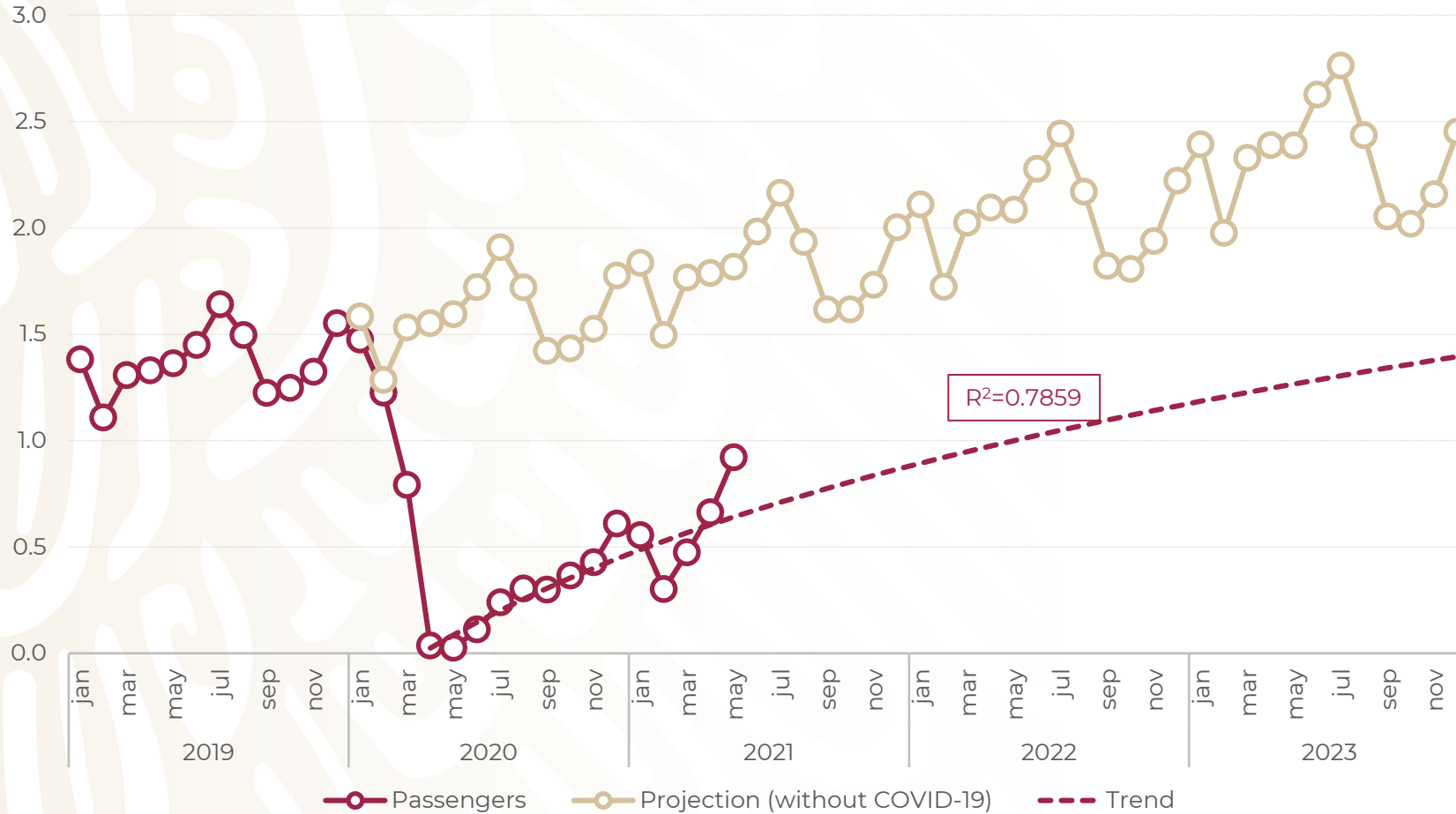

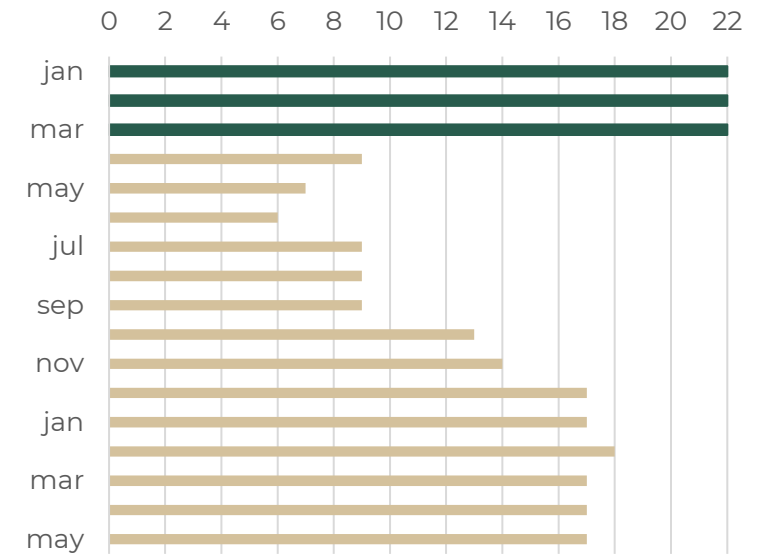


**Monthly passengers transported in Scheduled International Operations

- Of the 6 Mexican passenger airlines that operate internationally, only one (Interjet) continues with the suspension of its operations. In 2019, Interjet carried 29.0% of international passengers (ranking second), so an eventual return to operation would mean a considerable boost for recovery.
- The trend curve indicates a slow return over several years, in the international market of passengers transported by Mexican airlines.

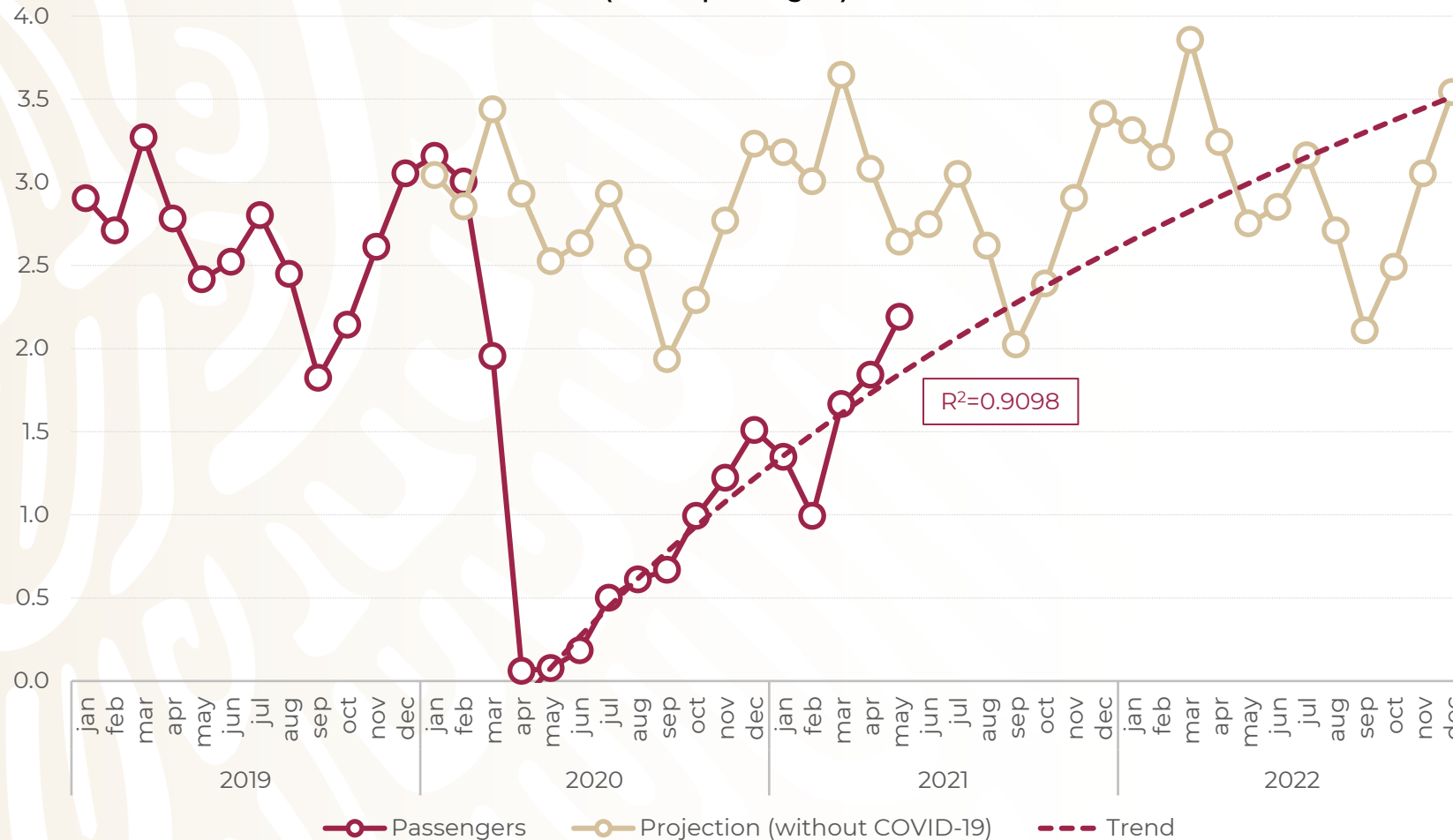
Countries served by Mexican airlines

(million passengers)



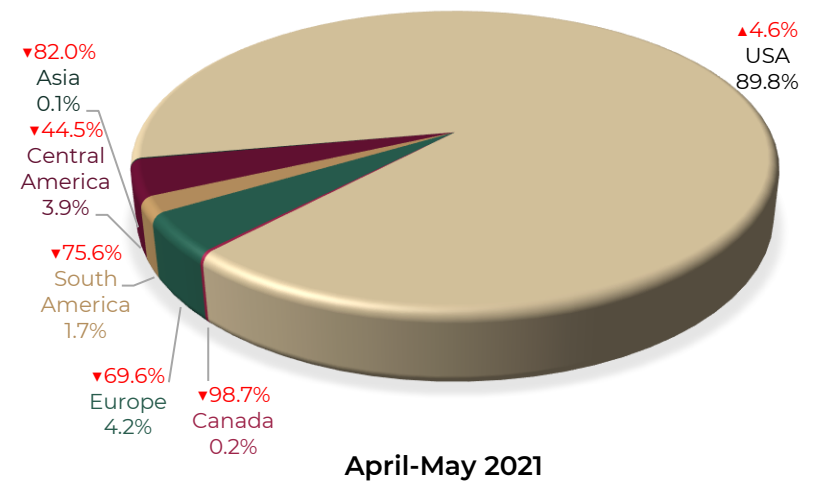
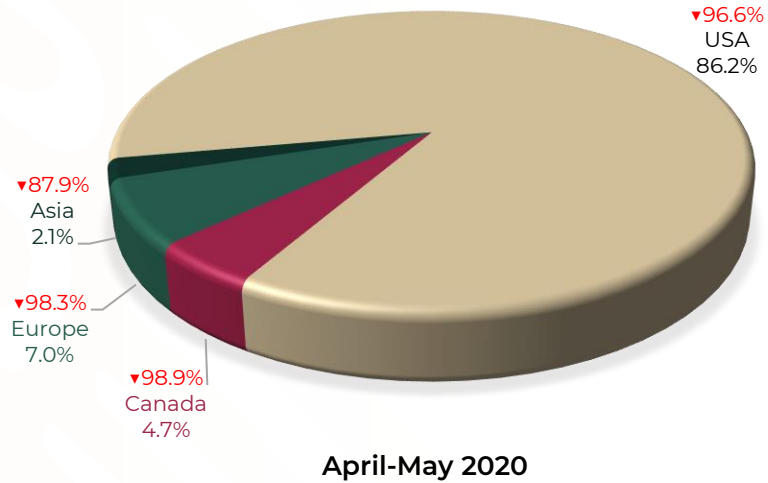
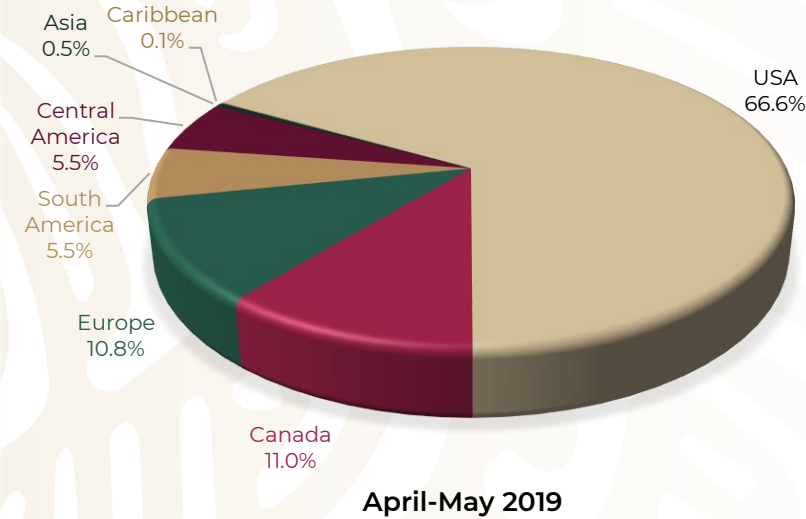
- For foreign passenger airlines, depending on the country of origin, there were (and persist) travel restrictions.
- The greatest restrictions have been in Asia, Europe and South America.
- Regarding the United States Airlines, those considered Regional stopped operating between April and July. Two Airlines have ceased operations.
- And, for Canadian Airlines, an executive order was issued restricting operations to Mexico from February 1st to April 30.
- The trend curve indicates a recovery between the third and last quarter of 2021, in passengers transported by foreign airlines.

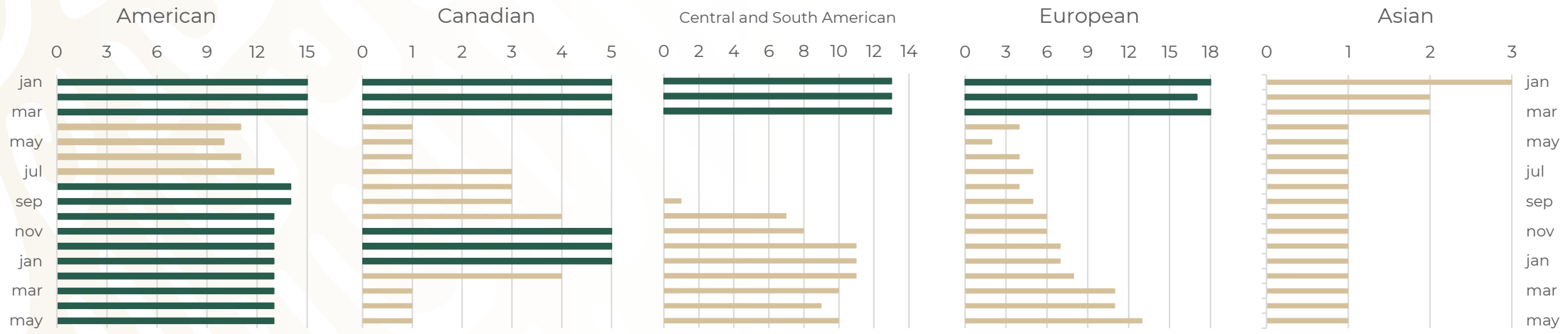
Percentage share of passengers transported to the different Regions

Number of Airlines with at least one Scheduled International Operation, according to Airline region.

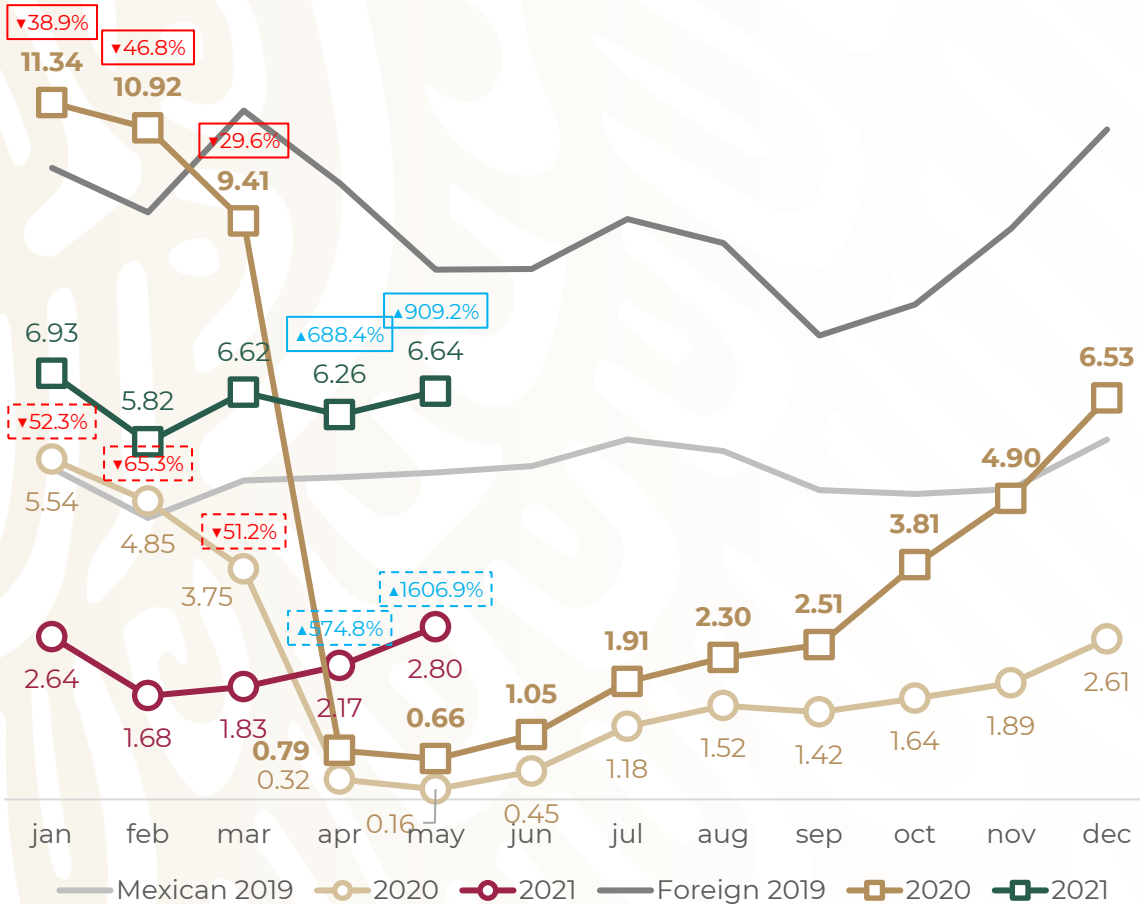
* The months in which all the Airlines operated are shown in green.



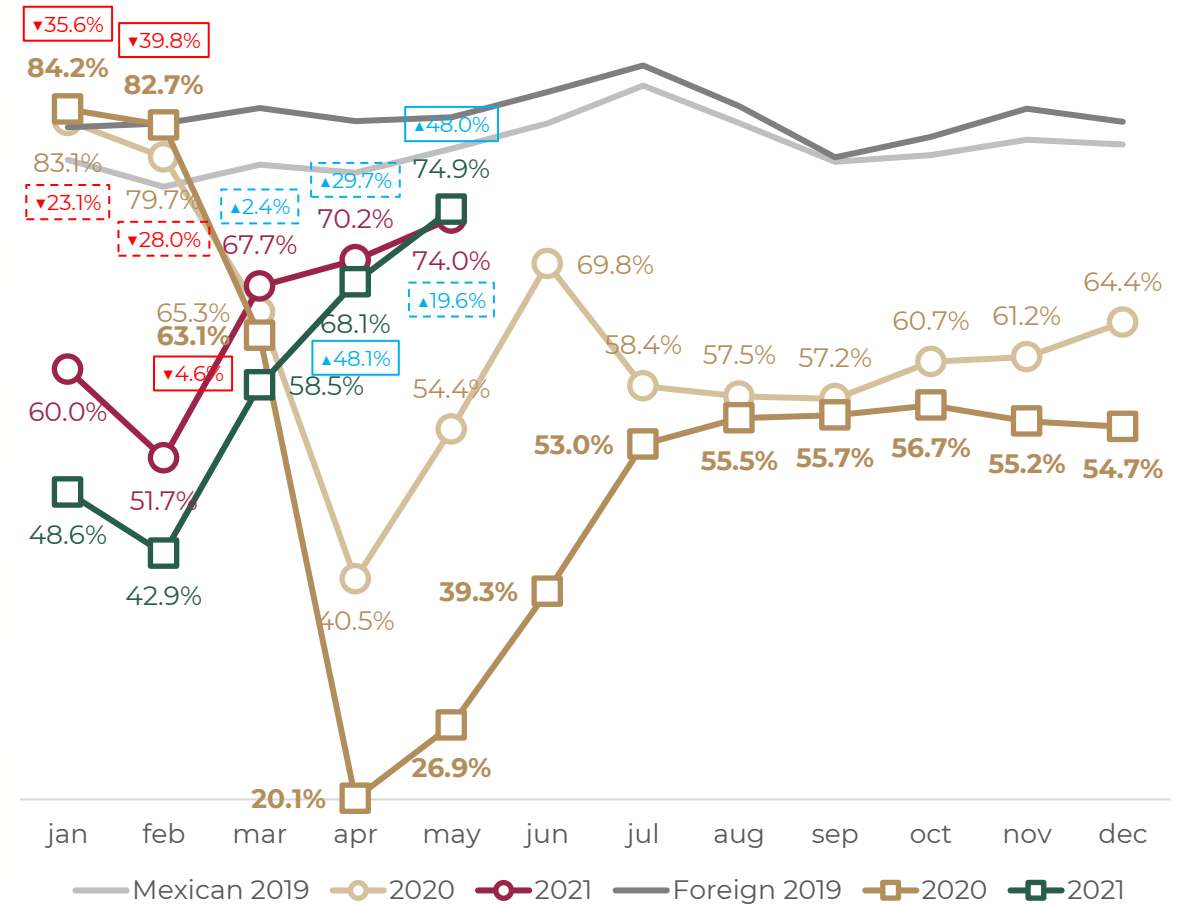
