Organic food is obtained from animals, vegetables, their products, and by-products, elaborated and processed in a friendly way.

Organic food is produced avoiding the use of synthetic products, such as pesticides, herbicides, and artificial fertilizers; thus, providing the confidence that they have been certified to be denominated and marketed as "organic" in their labeling. These products bear the National Distinctive "ORGANIC MEXICO", which is regulated by the <u>Secretariat of Agriculture</u>, through Senasica, which oversees the control system to ensure the integrity of organic products in Mexico.
