UNAM-Senasica Agreement

Through a collaboration agreement, the National Service for Agri-Food Health, Safety and Quality (Senasica) and the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine and Animal Husbandry of the National Autonomous University of Mexico (UNAM) developed the project: *"Study of some of the factors that influence the loss of bee colonies in different states of beekeeping importance in the Mexican Republic, fiscal year 2017"*.

The project evaluates the main problems in beekeeping, focusing on diseases and pesticide residues in beehives in six beekeeping regions (Peninsula, Pacific, Altiplano, Gulf and North) of the Mexican Republic.
