

Other domestic animals

If you want to enter Mexico with an animal, other than a dog or cat, you must comply with what is indicated in the Consultation Module of the Zoosanitary Importation Requirements

With the following data:

1. Full name, RFC, CURP and address
2. Telephone number with area code
3. Contact email address
4. Animal species and zootechnical function
5. Country of origin
6. Country of provenance
7. Destination or end use of the merchandise
8. Additional information that you consider may provide technical and documentary support to your request
9. Customs through which you would enter

Considerations

Agriculture-Senasica will carry out a risk analysis and, if appropriate, will establish the requirements in a Zoosanitary Requirements Sheet (HRZ).

You must cover the cost of the Zoosanitary Certificate for Importation (**\$ 2,479.00**) for terrestrial species and (**\$ 2,502.00**) for aquatic species, in accordance with the Federal Law of Rights in force). You can download the payment form at [e5cinco](#)

Notes:

If you send an animal documented as cargo, it is important that you verify the requirements in the airline of your choice and consider the need to use the services of a customs agent for its release, after compliance with non-tariff regulations by Agriculture-Senasica.
