

## National Epidemiological Surveillance System SIVE

The main objective of SIVE is to monitor the behavior of animal diseases and pests

The National Epidemiological Surveillance System (SIVE; *Sistema Nacional de Vigilancia Epidemiológica*), of the National Service for Agro-alimentary Public Health, Safety and Quality (Senasica), monitors health alerts on animal health at the national level, collects, analyzes and processes health information from diseases and pests of animals at the national level and allows to anticipate and identify the presence of outbreaks of the same, so that once the risks are detected, action is taken in a timely manner for their prevention, control and/or eradication.

The diseases and pests that SIVE monitors are divided into three types:

1. Exotic, i.e., they do not exist in the country because they have never been present or because they have already been eradicated.
2. Endemic, which are present in some regions of the country included under animal health campaign programs or epidemiological surveillance, since they have a high health, economic, commercial and, in some cases, public health impact.
3. Monthly report endemics, exclusive to some areas of the Mexican Republic and with less health, economic and marketing impact.
