

## Self-declarations of Mexico before the OIE

To facilitate the trade of goods, the self-declaration of Mexico as free of some diseases is carried out.

In accordance with the guidelines of the Terrestrial Animal Health Code ([Terrestrial Code](#)) or the Aquatic Animal Health Code ([Aquatic Code](#)), OIE Members may choose to declare freedom from a disease in their territory, zone or compartment.

To facilitate the trade of goods, Mexico has carried out the self-declaration as free of the following diseases:

Each year, Mexico endorses its classification as a country with negligible risk of bovine spongiform encephalopathy (BSE) in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 11.4. of the [Terrestrial Code](#).
