

# Forbidden products

Avoid trouble at your arrival.

## Vegetable sourced

Dirt or soil.

Pots or articles with vegetable or unknown contents.

The introduction by tourists of the products listed below is prohibited if the importer fails to meet the requirements set forth in the following

Propagative materials (seeds, bulbs, cuttings, buds, stakes, etc.)

Flowers, plants, in vitro plantlets, fresh vegetables and fruits.

Grains (corn, black bean, rice, quinoa, wheat, sesame, sunflower, cowpea, lentil, etc.)

Green coffee and tobacco.

Fresh chestnuts.

## Animal sourced

Balanced feed for any species (except for cats and dogs.)

Balanced food for cats and dogs with beef, lamb and goat meat.

Fresh meat from any species.

Containers carrying animals, or animal remains (blood, feathers, bones, waste, others.)

Any regulated animal species (except cats and dogs.)

Garments with animal bones, skin, and feathers, horn, or carved or polished bone craftwork, if stained with blood or any other materials propagative of diseases or pests.

Their introduction is allowed when the presence of the aforementioned materials is discarded, and the product's characteristics are established as a non-sanitary risk.

Bullfighting, Mexican horsemanship (charrería) and bull riding garments and paraphernalia, when stained with animal blood or tissues. Their introduction is allowed if they are completely cleaned, disinfected and undergo sanitary treatment at the point of entry.

Homemade or artisanal products are not allowed.

Campero-type (fried) chicken.

Pork products and their subproducts sourced from countries affected by the African swine flu: ham, sausages, bacon, cracklings, candy with pork meat, raw pork meat, dry meat, smoked chops, precooked cold cuts, pasta with pork meat, BBQ ribs, pork lard, instantaneous soups with pork content, bacon toothpaste, salami, mortadella, ham sandwich, chorizo, etc.

Untanned leather products.

Pharmaceutical, chemical, and biological products for animal use or consumption, or products indicated for therapeutic or research purposes.

Fresh cheeses.

Sandwiches, snacks, sub and Cuban sandwiches, hamburgers, pizzas, etc. with meat and dairy contents without an intact packaging or a sanitary seal from the competent authority.

Game trophies (mounted, fresh, salted, etc.)

Pots or articles with animal, vegetable or unknown contents.

**Aquatic sourced**

Live, raw, and dry crustaceans.

Aquaculture products (except fillets and fish for animal consumption.)

Fish.

Live turtles.

Regulated aquatic products in bad condition, rotting, or containing larvae or insects.
