Fiscal Year 2019

The National Plant Health, Safety and Quality Service (Senasica), aims to preserve and improve sanitary conditions and agro-alimentary safety, through the implementation of priority projects for epidemiological surveillance, plant health, aquaculture and fishing campaigns, contamination risk reduction system actions, and inspection in the mobilization of agricultural production.

Therefore, Senasica implements the Agro-alimentary Health and Safety Program, which is aligned with Guideline 3 "Inclusive Economic Development", which aims to raise the income of producers and rural employment under the Guidelines for the National Development Plan 2019-2024, as set out in the 2019 Programming and Budget Manual.

Therefore, based on the Agreement by which the Operating Rules of the Agro-alimentary Health and Safety Program of the Secretariat of Agriculture and Rural Development are disclosed, for the 2019 fiscal year, it will have the following Components:

1. Epidemiological Surveillance of Quarantine Pests and Diseases.
2. Epidemiological Inspection and Surveillance of Non-Quarantine Regulated Pests and Diseases.
3. Plant Health Campaigns
4. Agrifood, Aquaculture and Fishery Safety.

These are subjected to the budget authorized by the Decree of the Expenditure Budget of the Federation for fiscal year 2019.
