This tick is found in countries such as:

- USA
- Australia
- Korea
- Russia
- Japan
- Pacific Islands
- New Zealand
- China

Cows, sheep, horses, dogs, cats, and wildlife mammals and birds can get the parasite.

Remember, before introducing new animals to your facilities, have in place an inspection and quarantine program, and use the ixodicide treatments in a responsible manner and only with products registered with SADER-SENASICA.
