- 1 If you notice the following signs in your pigs:
- Loss of appetite
- Weakness
- Fever
- Nasal discharge
- Breathing difficulty
- Vomi
- Purple or black coloring of skin (mainly ears and abdomen)
- Mucous and bloody diarrhea
 - Abortions
 - High mortality

REPORT!

- 2 Reinforce the biosafety measures in your porcine production unit.
- If you visit any farm, before exiting wash and disinfect your clothes and shoes.
- Wash and disinfect vehicles and containers before and after transporting live animals, meat or products.
- 5 Do not move diseased or dead pigs outside your production unit.
- Take all necessary precautions to prevent that your pigs get in contact with wild pigs, since they can easily spread many diseases.

African swine fever is not present in our country; therefore, we need to prevent it. It is a devastating disease that spreads quickly and can kill 100% of the pigs in a production unit in little time.

THERE IS NO PREVENTIVE VACCINE OR TREATMENT TO CURE THE DISEASE

Luckily the disease does not affect humans, but we can spread it through infected pig products, clothes and shoes.
