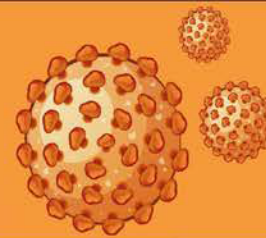


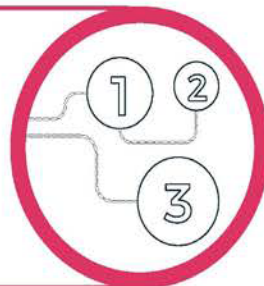
Recommendations for veterinarians taking care of our pets



If you take care of yourself, you take care of everybody



Mark out the clean, grey and dirty areas of your office.



If you suspect that an animal was infected by a diseased human, please inform to the SENASICA.

Take into consideration the clinical record of the pet (COVID-19 history in close individuals).



Collect samples from deep nasopharyngeal swabs and store in refrigeration for analysis at SENASICA's laboratory. If the pet is hospitalized, an official personnel member will take this sample.

Recommend to the **owners and caregivers** that *have* been infected with **COVID-19** to limit contact with their pets and implement the recommendations given by the **Secretariat of Health**.
