The SENASICA will visit you to review the documents and also visit some producers to get to know how they operate and meet the requirements for small producers that operate within the SCOP.

If the SCOP meets the requirements, you will be **certified** for 5 years.

The SENASICA will follow-up and supervise compliance with the LPO.
