RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PURCHASING, HANDLING AND APPLYING PESTICIDES



Verify the following: the pesticide is in its original container, without any leaks or cracks, with a whole label and seal of guarantee and with a current RSCO registry; also check its expiration date.



Carefully read the label; the pesticide must be authorized for use in the crop and the pest to control.



Do not store pesticides together with personal use objects or food. Store the pesticides in an exclusive location, locked and out of reach of animals or unauthorized individuals.



Check that you have the appropriate personal protection equipment for the pesticide. This information appears on its label.



Calibrate the application equipment. Please ask your Plant Health State Committee in case of doubt.




Apply only the recommended amount (dose) of pesticide. Do not mix with other



Regarding purchases get advice from specialists on the subject. Please ask your Plant Health State Committee in case of doubt



After pesticide application, change your clothes and take a shower. Wash the clothes you use separately from your family's clothes.



Wash the empty container thrice. Separate the lid, perforate the container, and take them both to the nearest primary collection center. Ask the Plant Health State Committee in case of doubt.



No leftovers should remain in the application equipment. Any leftovers must be applied to the same crop, never to any source of water or other crops.

> Observe the safety window, which is the number of days since the last application and until the day of harvest.





Do not eat or drink, smoke or chew gum while applying pesticide. Never put the pieces of the application equipment in your mouth.

In the event of intoxication:

- If the pesticide touches your skin, take a shower and change into clean clothes.
- If the pesticide touches your eyes, wash them with lots of water during 15 minutes.
- If pesticide is swallowed do not induce vomit and make sure you can breathe by lying on your side.
- If you inhaled the pesticide, move to a well ventilated area with fresh air.
- Go to the nearest medical center.
