

# Training process

SENASICA, through the General Directorate of Plant and Animal Health Inspection (DGIF), has the Canine School, where canine units with a high level of olfactory detection of agricultural products regulated by the Secretariat of Agriculture are formed, in order to support and expedite the inspection of goods and baggage of passengers transiting through ports, airports, borders and points of national movement, to avoid the introduction and spread of pests or diseases that may threaten the health status of the country.
