Dog selection process

Currently, all dogs trained at the Dog School come from shelters, dog control centers and individual donations. For their admission they must fulfill qualities such as: being pleasant, playful, sweet and free of signs of diseases that may affect their development and activities. Therefore, physical, behavioral, temperament and reaction tests to environmental factors are performed.

Once selected, dogs are moved from the shelter or animal rescue center to the School and kept in quarantine for a period of at least 15 days, during which several laboratory and radiographic studies are carried out, to rule out diseases that could limit their activity.
