Joint actions lead to higher efficiency

The SENASICA and the CNA (National Agriculture and Livestock Board) coordinate actions to protect the agro-alimentary production.



The SENASICA and the CNA formed a Monitoring Commission that will coordinate and supervise their joint actions, arising from the commitments undertaken in the Consensus Agreement signed in 2020.

The CNA, as a strategic ally of the SENASICA, represents over 80% of the Mexican agriculture and livestock, aquaculture, and fishery producers.

To reinforce their synergy, the SENASICA and the CNA formed a Monitoring Commission that will coordinate and supervise their joint actions that aim to boost the actions already in operation, pursuant to the commitments undertaken in the Consensus Agreement signed in 2020.

The organizations agreed to form two permanent work groups to address plant and animal health issues, who will be complemented, when required, by specialists in health inspection, agro-alimentary, aquaculture and fishery safety, and projects and institutional development.
