Before Applying for an Aquaculture Health Certificate for Importation

Learn about the requirements you must meet

If you cannot find the requirements for your goods in the <u>Aquaculture</u> <u>Health Requirements Consultation Module for Imports (MCRSA)</u> and you need to import aquatic species, their products and by-products, as well as biological, chemical, pharmaceutical, or food products for the use or consumption of these species, you can request them to SENASICA through the <u>SENASICA-01-045</u> procedure.

SENASICA may modify, update and/or create new requirements, depending on the country of origin or provenance and the risk of goods to be imported or, as the case may be, waive requirements, in order to mitigate risks or ensure greater protection of the national territory.

All this is based on the agro-ecological conditions associated with the development, establishment, or eradication of pests or diseases in the country of origin or in the origin of the goods that intend to enter the country, as well as the principles set forth in the section on sanitary and phytosanitary measures of the World Trade Organization with regards to recommendations of recognized international organizations, in the power of the Members to determine them based on scientific evidence, risk analysis, international recommendations and/or in the evaluation of risks associated to the goods, as well as the equivalence and mutual recognition between Mexico and the countries with which the commercial exchange is kept.
