

# A Good Hunter does not Hunt Risks

If you hunt wild boar or pigs abroad, do not bring them into Mexico.

African Swine Fever is not present in our country, but it is a devastating disease for pig farming due to its rapid dissemination and high mortality rate, which can reach 100%.

THIS DISEASE DOES NOT AFFECT HUMANS but we can be the means of transmission if we do not wash and disinfect vehicles, clothing, footwear, hunting equipment and gear.

Join the actions to prevent their entry into Mexico:

- If you go hunting abroad or visit a swine production unit, wash and disinfect your clothes, footwear and equipment *before* leaving the place.
- Do not enter the country with animals and products from hunting, including trophies.
- Respect any hunting prohibition set by the authorities.
- If you notice a sick boar or pig, REPORT IT to the relevant authorities.
- Allow SENASICA health authorities to check your baggage and equipment at inspection points.

Don't risk pork production, avoid shortages and rising prices, it's for everyone's sake!
