40 years of TIF and counting...

TIF establishments, professionalism and commitment to consumer health



The Federal Type Inspection System (TIF) is, for the Mexican government, one of the main standards of health, safety and quality of the food produced and processed in our country. The companies that form this system have showed professionalism and commitment to the health and well-being of consumers.

For this reason, TIF establishments have become the guideline for the rest of agro-alimentary fields, since all their production processes for four decades have shown compliance with regulations on animal health and safety in meat processing. This commitment has resulted in the fact that these are the only meat suppliers in the Mexican self-service stores, and are acknowledged by health authorities of more than 70 countries to export their meat. Its work is monitored by more than 800 authorized veterinary doctors (MVRA, in Spanish) by the SENASICA.

Currently, the health authority and industry are working to expand its reach and trigger a High Performance Pilot Program, through which six companies are sought to be the model of the rest, with the conviction of further increasing the safety guarantees of their products.
