## Enough and safe chicken and eggs supply

## Poultry production runs normally



Through the work of specialized technicians, SENASICA applied total final quarantines and implemented optimal sanitary provisions

Up to now, the Secretariat of Agriculture has reported no new cases of highly pathogenic avian influenza (IAAP) AH5N1, after the detection of an outbreak ten days ago, in three poultry production units (UPA) in the municipalities of Uman and Timucuy, in Yucatán.

Moreover, through specialized technicians, SENASICA applied total final quarantines and implemented optimal sanitary provisions, which involve depopulation, cleaning and disinfection of farms, as well as bird sanitary provisions, under the supervision of official staff of the Directorate General for Animal Health. As part of the actions, to prevent the spread of the virus, SENASICA ordered the internal quarantine of UPA's in Yucatán, which, among other measures, it considers the control of movement of the region's poultry products.

As a result, all UPA's in the finding region must demonstrate the products to be moved and marketed are free of AH5N1 IAAP virus. For this purpose, it is necessary to show the negative results of the tests performed in official laboratories or authorized laboratories by the Secretariat of Agriculture.
