

Agro-alimentary Health and Safety Program 2022

The National Service for Agro-alimentary Public Health, Safety and Quality Service (SENASICA) aims to preserve and improve sanitary and food safety conditions, through phytozoosanitary epidemiological surveillance, phytozoosanitary, aquaculture and fishery campaigns, pollution risk mitigation systems and good agricultural, livestock, aquaculture and fishery production practices, and primary processing of aquaculture and fishery products.

Based on the above, the SENASICA implements the Agro-alimentary Health and Safety Program (PSIA), which is aligned to Axis 3 “Economy”, section “Food self-sufficiency and rescuing the field” of the National Development Plan 2019-2024, as well as the Agriculture and Rural Development Sector Program 2020-2024, in Objective 1. Achieving food self-sufficiency through increased agricultural, aquaculture and fishery production and productivity; Strategy 1.5 Strengthen agricultural, aquaculture and fishery health and safety for healthy and nutritious food production.

The Program and its Components are subject to the budget authorized by the Federal Expenditure Budget Decree for fiscal year 2022.

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
