The growing commercial development of Mexico, since joining the World Trade Organization and signing trade agreements with other countries, has increased its risk for pests and diseases that do not exist in the national territory; therefore, the need for enabling infrastructure that facilitates the exchange of agricultural products in ports, airports and borders has risen.

Our country established a health protection system to minimize the risk factors involved in trading agricultural goods with the entire world. Nontariff activities, such as health and phytosanitary activities, develop a significant dimension in every country and ours is not an exception. Both at international and domestic levels, the movement of agricultural products poses a constant health risk due to the fact that every federal entity has distinctive characteristics and health perspectives.
