In accordance with the Sixth Agreement, number 6, in connection with “Functions,” subparagraphs e), h), k), o) last paragraph, as well as number 12 of the Agreement for issuing the [Code of Ethics for public servants of the Federal Government](#), Rules of Integrity for holding public office and General Guidelines to promote the integrity of public servants and to implement permanent actions favoring their ethical behavior, through Committees of Ethics and Prevention of Conflicts of Interest, published in the Official Gazette on August 20, 2015, Committees of Ethics and Prevention of Conflicts of Interest (CEPCI) of agencies and entities of the Federal Public Government are required to release and disclose the following information:
