Industrial, commercial, or importing establishments of veterinary products and raw materials are regulated to ensure that they comply with the laws and regulations in force in Mexico to guarantee that their activities do not jeopardize animal health, food safety and the quality of the products they manufacture or import. Likewise, the issuance of certificates and certificates to establishments in compliance with the laws and regulations in force in Mexico for the export of products to other countries is conciliated.
