

Phytopsanitary diagnosis moving laboratory

Query Information

The Mobile Phytopsanitary Diagnostic Laboratory (LMDF) of the Directorate of the National Phytopsanitary Reference Center (CNRF), since 2012 has been conducting “in situ” and remote diagnostics, mainly attending to the diagnosis of the bacterium causing HLB (*Candidatus Liberibacter asiaticus*), the results are issued in the shortest possible time, so that regulatory and interested areas can apply the relevant measures.

This service has been provided to states such as Oaxaca, Tabasco, Veracruz, Tamaulipas, Nuevo León, San Luis Potosí, Baja California, Baja California Sur, Puebla, Yucatán, Campeche, and Chiapas. This has supported the Plant Regulation and Protection Area Directorates, the State Plant Health Committees, the Plant Epidemiological Surveillance Program and, above all, citrus growers, informing them of the phytopsanitary condition of their plantations.
