Frequently Asked Questions-Export SV

What do I need to export plant products?

It is necessary to comply with the phytosanitary requirements set by the importing country, as the shipments to be exported must be certified based on these requirements, which prevents setbacks at the point of entry to the destination country such as retentions, rejections or destruction of the product and avoids economic losses that will have a direct impact on the exporter.

How can I know the phytosanitary requirements of the place to export?

In an Agreement or Work Plan

In an Addendum

In the legislation of the importing country:

- Regulations / Standards
- Phytosanitary requirements sheet
- Import permit
- In consultation with embassies or Senasica.

Who performs phytosanitary certification in Mexico?

The Sader, through Senasica, to guarantee that plants, their products and by-products exported or re-exported by Mexico comply with the phytosanitary requirements established by the importing countries, certifies compliance with these requirements by issuing a document called International Phytosanitary Certificate (CFI).

What is the CFI?

It is the official document issued by Sader's Authorized Phytosanitary Officers, which certifies compliance with the

requirements set by the importing country. It specifies the quantity, presentation, origin, destination, among other information that identifies the merchandise for export purposes. It is issued at the place of origin of the merchandise.

In what cases is the CFI issued?

When the country to which you intend to export requests it, or according to the phytosanitary requirements that it determines for each product (for example: apple, lemon, chili, pineapple, among others).

How many species can be included in a CFI?

One CFI is issued per product or species. If the importing country accepts it, several species can be included.

What documents do I need to complete the process?

Verification report (show the original document when paying at the bank window) and proof of payment. According to the current fee in the Federal Law of Rights (article 86-A Fraction III), during 2018 the cost of the CFI is \$533.

Note: It should be noted that fees are modified on yearly basis.
