Mexico and the United States establish a Compliance Committee



The Organic Compliance Committee has the function of achieving the objectives of the Work Program established for the signing of the Equivalence Agreement, and it will consist of technicians from the two countries.

The Committee will determine training priorities for producers and certification bodies, among which is the organization of an equivalence workshop for certification bodies in Mexico and the United States.

Achieving equivalence will speed up the processes of safe commercial exchange of organic products between Mexico and the United States, for the benefit of producers and consumers of the two nations.

In addition, it will promote the identity of Mexican organic products and reduce certification costs for both producers and industry.

Additionally, the operation of the Mexican Control System is strengthened, making it more competitive to the national organic sector, since it offers consumers greater guarantees on the organic integrity of the products.
