

Phytosanitary Requirements Module

The Phytosanitary Requirements Module for Importing goods under regulation by Sader, in plant health matters, is an online reference system which contains applicable plant health measures for importing goods of plant origin, in order to prevent regulated pests from being introduced into and spread throughout Mexico, and thus protect the phytosanitary condition of our country.

In the event of a phytosanitary emergency that poses a risk to plant health in Mexico, the Secretariat, through Senasica, shall update or modify the phytosanitary measures for risk mitigation in the "Phytosanitary Requirements Module for Imports", in terms of Federal Plant Health Law and its Regulations, which will enter into force immediately.

As for amending phytosanitary measures that are already established, not connected with a phytosanitary emergency, a notification will be generated in which it will be indicated that the product is undergoing a risk assessment and that in connection therewith, an amendment may be entered into the "Phytosanitary Requirements Module for Imports." Therefore, as long as an amendment of phytosanitary measures in the Module is not carried out, private entities may continue using the information displayed therein.
