Cactus Moth

Pest under economic surveillance

This pest feeds on cacti and is considered an important pest of plants of the genus Opuntia (nopal). Due to the economic, ecological, aesthetic and cultural value that these species have in Mexico, since the reintroduction of C. cactorum to Mexico, this pest would put at risk Opuntia species, which grow wild and cultivated as vegetable, forage and prickly pear cactus.
