We boost the welfare of small producers and the national food supply



In 2023, the SENASICA will invest over 5 billion Mexican pesos to protect the agroalimentary sanitation of our country and drive actions that improve the welfare of small and medium scale producers and facilitate the international trade of food products to reinforce the national supply and help to bring down inflation. Every year, the agency of the Secretariat of Agriculture spends resources to operate epidemiological surveillance programs, plant and animal health campaigns, inspection actions at seaports, airports, and borders, and establish, upon a petition by an interested party, contamination risk reduction systems in agriculture, livestock, aquaculture, and fishery production units.

The work of over five thousand specialists working at 30 federated states, with the support of farmers, stock breeders, and the fishery industry, has positioned Mexico as a world model on the subject, and among the top five countries with the best food sanitation and quality status.

To clarify and speed up sanitation and safety actions, which provide certainty to our producers and trade partners, the SENASICA presented its 2023 work plan, which establishes actions to reinforce the transparency and accountability of the programs and actions operated by this sanitary agency of the Mexican government.
