Agile and safe inspections to guarantee food supply

The SENASICA is working to lower the risk of introducing exotic pests and diseases to our national territory, thus guaranteeing the sanitary conditions of the foods consumed in Mexico, for the benefit of consumers and to protect the sustenance of small and medium scale producers, mostly.

During 2022, 1,609 officials of the agency of the Secretariat of Agriculture inspected the documentation and safety conditions and authorized the introduction of over 43 million metric tons of goods at 436 seaports, airports, border crossings, and strategic road checkpoints.

Thanks to the foregoing activity, the SENASICA rejected 2,665 shipments that did not meet the import sanitary requirements, thus preventing the introduction of 191 quarantine pests that entailed a risk for our country's agro-alimentary resources.

The SENASICA is working to update proposals to speed-up the safe trade of food, with the ultimate goal of protecting food production in Mexico by ensuring the strict compliance with sanitary measures as its pivotal element.
