

## Social Comptroller

Establishes participation mechanisms for the beneficiaries of federal programs to carry out control and surveillance actions.

The main function of the Social Comptroller is to establish participation mechanisms for the beneficiaries of federal programs to carry out control and surveillance actions in an organized or independent manner with the purpose of contributing to ensure that government management and the handling of public resources are carried out in terms of transparency, efficacy, legality and honesty.

The purpose of this space is to provide users with information on Social Comptroller activities related to the Agrifood Health and Safety Program (PSIA, by its Spanish acronym) by generating and disseminating material and information of interest for the creation of Social Comptroller Committees (CCS, by its Spanish acronym) and the documentary support of the activities they carry out. In addition to training and advice to facilitate monitoring and supervision of compliance with the goals and the correct application of the resources assigned to the PSIA by the Social Comptroller Committees.
