National Service of Agrifood Health, Safety and Quality (Servicio Nacional de Sanidad, Inocuidad y Calidad Agroalimentaria) | June 22, 2021

The National Service of Health, Safety and Agrifood Quality (Senasica, by its Spanish acronym), is in charge of approving certification bodies, testing laboratories and verification units, as well as authorizing responsible veterinarians, third party specialists and laboratories to work as collaborators in animal health activities.

In turn, it promotes the regulation of processing establishments, importers and marketers of veterinary products, raw materials, chemical, pharmaceutical, biological products, diagnostic kits and food for livestock use or consumption, as well as rendering plants.

The above, in order to guarantee that there are companies that supply reliable and high quality livestock goods that allow maintaining and improving animal production and food safety, so that the consumer has food free of pests, diseases and contaminants.
