

Movement of sports and showhorses

For the movement of horses within national territory

The Sports and Show Horses Sanitary and Identification Passport (PSIC, in Spanish) is an official document for the movement within the national territory of horses for sports or show purposes: polo, horse riding, horse racing, jumping, horsemanship, dance, expos or fairs, by submitting only the corresponding movement notice (Senasica-01-060-A).

A veterinarian in charge authorized by the SADER-SENASICA for equine activities periodically records in the PSIC the health status of the horse, laboratory diagnosis, vaccinations and any treatment applied to the horse, and validates the document with his/her signature.

To obtain the PSIC go to the SADER state office of your choice and submit the following:

1. Signed application with the data of the owner and the authorized veterinarian in charge, and the domicile of the ranch or production unit where the horse is located.
2. Certificate issued by the [Authorized Veterinarian in charge](#) indicating that the horse is for sports/show activities and

kept in stables with known domicile, and a summary of the horse shall also be submitted.

After obtaining the PSIC, access sistemas.senasica.gob.mx to generate the Horse Movement Notice (AMC, in Spanish), [Senasica-01-060-A](#) procedure.

With a valid PSIC and the AMC you can move your horses without any restrictions to participate in sports and show circuits across the country and without needing the Movement Zoosanitary Certificate.

Remember! The passport and the movement notice are free of charge.
