

National Inspection System

Activities

The National Inspection System coordinates 85 Agriculture and Livestock Health Inspection Offices (OISA). The satellite offices technically and administratively report to the branch offices and to 19 Federal Inspection and Verification points (PVIF).

The personnel in charge of carrying out inspections of important national movement agricultural and livestock, aquaculture and fishery products consists of veterinarians-zootechnicians, agricultural engineers and biologists.

These professionals are properly identified and uniformed to carry out phytozoosanitary, aquaculture and fishery verification, inspection and certification services.
