Mexico in the Open Government Partnership

The national action plans comprise the set of commitments created collaboratively by Corporation and government under the leadership of the Coordinating Committee, in the framework of Mexico's participation in the Open Government Partnership.

Since the first action plan presented in 2011, Mexico has strengthened the open government process by designing increasingly robust methodologies to promote greater citizen participation in the construction of national action plans.

This is visible in the different commitments that have been co-created, while the first commitments only responded to specific requests from organizations participating in the open government process within the framework of the Alliance, the commitments of the Third and Fourth plans incorporate the lessons learned from the previous plans, with a public policy perspective and a Human Rights approach and also align with other efforts such as the 2030 Agenda for sustainable development, the gender perspective and the inclusion of people with disabilities.
