Entry to products without ruminant content and in the company of your dog or cat is allowed.

### General considerations:

- They must come from countries that have a combination of requirements in the [Animal Health Requirements for Importation Consultation Module](#)
- Products may be packaged and labeled in Spanish or English.
- May be presented in a single package or up to two as long as it does not exceed the permitted quantity.
- In bulk, only what corresponds to the ration of the day accompanied by the pet will be accepted.
